DID YOU KNOW...ST. MARTIN MONASTERY AND ACADEMY: RAPID CITY

In 1962, the Benedictine community moved to a new monastery and academy complex on the western edge of Rapid City. The monastery featured a beautiful chapel, a large kitchen and dining room, and housing for the sisters. In addition to classrooms, there was residence living for high school students who attended the academy. Nestled in a valley and surrounded by hills, the sisters prayed and taught in an idyllic setting. The former St. Martin Monastery property in Rapid City was recently acquired by the Diocese of Rapid City and the Rapid City Catholic School System and is now called *Terra Sancta*.
