“One Catholic Teaching - Pope Benedict also insists that there is one Catholic teaching which unites the church’s moral and social doctrine, such that the teachings about the protection of human life and dignity, the defense of marriage and the family, the protection of the poor, the pursuit of economic justice and the practice of solidarity are all one. When a society moves towards the denial or suppression of life, it ends up no longer finding the necessary motivation and energy to strive for man's true good. If personal and social sensitivity towards the acceptance of a new life is lost, then other forms of acceptance that are valuable for society also wither away.”

DID YOU KNOW...FORMER MONASTERY NOW CALLED TERRA SANCTA

In 2007, the Sisters at St. Martin Monastery decided that a new monastery would better suit their needs. However, they wanted to keep the sacred character of the St. Martin property and believed that the Diocese of Rapid City and the Rapid City Catholic School System would continue their mission of bringing people closer to God. To make this possible, they significantly reduced the price of the 150,000 square foot building and 200 acres and accepted an offer from the diocese and the school system. The purchase was completed in 2009. The former St. Martin Monastery property is now called *Terra Sancta*, which is Latin for Holy Land, to honor the sisters who made the ground holy through their many years of service and prayer.
