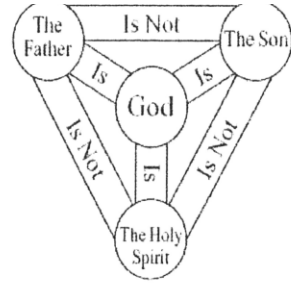

who came to earth to be my friend and brother.

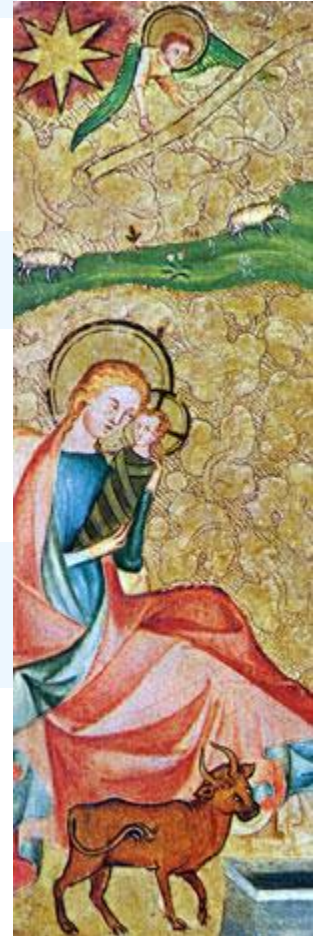
He was conceived
